

There's been a slight increase in thefts in the Indian Land area in the past week or so. On Saturday night, a DJ working at the Carolina Bistro reported his car was stolen from the parking lot between 8:00 PM and 11:40 PM. He stated the keys were not in the vehicle but couldn't say whether or not it was locked. The vehicle is a silver Town and Country mini-van with SC tag EZZ 950.

The following day some items were stolen from an unlocked vehicle in the same parking lot while the vehicle's owner was cleaning inside SC Bank & Trust between 10:00 AM and 11:30 AM. There have also been some scattered thefts from newly constructed homes. Please be vigilant as people tend to get overly distracted this time of year. These incidents are not typical for Indian Land, but remember that Charlotte is just over the hill.

Be aware of your surroundings, always lock your car doors, don't leave valuables in plain sight and look out for those around you, too.
