

We have received recent information that a burglary ring out of Charlotte may be active again. This ring accounted for a couple of burglaries in the Indian Land area two years ago. This ring typically operates in teams of black males with white female drivers. The female drivers look less suspicious while parked on the street as people don't normally associate females with burglaries. The males approach the residence and ring the door bell to determine if anyone is at home. They sometimes leave the hood up on the vehicle and pretend to have vehicle problems. If no one is at home, they will force entry through a door and steal items such as TV's, computers, jewelry, etc. They use rental cars so don't assume that someone isn't suspicious just because they are in a nice vehicle. In recent weeks, they have been seen in Charlotte driving a red Dodge Durango SUV that was rented in Fort Mill.
