

I realize that this is delayed, but I was away from the office at the end of last week and our e-mail system was down over the weekend. We had several vehicles broken into in the Indian Land area last week. Most of these incidents occurred during the early morning hours on Thursday night/Friday morning. There were six incidents in BridgeMill, four in Windsor Trace, and at least one in Bel-Air.

There was also a vehicle stolen from a residence on Possum Hollow Rd. Out of these 12 incidents, 8 involved vehicles that were left unlocked. The vehicle that was stolen was unlocked with the keys inside of it. The items stolen included five GPS units, two iPods, two sets of speakers and a checkbook. In the four incidents where the vehicles were locked, the suspect gained entry by breaking a window.

This seems to happen at some point every year. The majority of the time, it involves vehicles that were left unlocked with high-value items in plain sight. Please do not make yourself an easy target.
