

I wanted to make you aware of the ongoing storage building burglaries the we are having in the Buford, Antioch, Shiloh Unity and Tradesville areas. I have read several incident reports from those areas in reference to burglaries to storage buildings. These burglars are forcing their way into these buildings (if they are secured) and taking, but not limited to, the following items: gas cans or containers, metal of any type (for scrap), hand tools, power tools, and yard tools (even old weed eaters and chain saws) . I ask that you or if you know someone who has a storage building to secure it at all times and to document everything that is inside it no matter what the condition and value of the items. Remember to contact the Sheriff's Office immediately if you see someone suspicious in your neighborhood.

Good Morning, I want to advise you the we have had several thefts of utility trailers in the Indian Land area and around the city of Lancaster. These trailers are small in size (approximately 6ft x 8ft in size) and usually valued less than \$1,000. These trailers are easy to maneuver and sometimes it only takes one person to hook it up. Each trailer has a serial number on them. You should be able to locate the serial number on the axels, the hitch near the jack and side frame. If you own a trailer please document the serial number of put some type of personal identification on it in a hidden location. FYI you can purchase several different types of trailer locks from your local hardware store.
