

I wanted to let you know that Lancaster county is continuing to have incidents of ATVs being stolen. The latest incident occurred in Indian Land area off of Barberville Road. The ATV was parked in the driveway where it stayed over the night. The subject(s) who stole the ATV pushed or pulled the ATV approximately 200 yards through the woods. Once the subject(s) came to a clearing it appears they then loaded the ATV onto either a trailer or into the back of a truck. At this time there is no suspects. I want to advise that if you do have an ATV to secure it to the best of your ability. Chains work well and if possible secure it in a storage building that can be locked. Also document the serial numbers, color, size, make, model and anything that you have added to it.
