

Good morning, after reviewing several incident reports I have noticed a possible trend between several crimes in the Indian land area. Within the past three weeks there have been 5 home burglaries on or near Henry Harris road. 4 of the home burglaries occurred on Henry Harris road and the 5th home burglary occurred in the BelAir sub-division which is near Henry Harris road. It's possible that some if not all the burglarizes are related due to the fact that 3 of the homes were vacant, and had been for a while, and the other two homes are positioned approximately 1 mile apart from the other. These two homes had several thousand dollars worth of jewelry and or electronic devices stolen from them. Along with the burglaries there were 2 vehicles that have been recently burglarized in the Legacy Park sub-division. Both vehicles contained items of value in them and the items were in plain sight. I would like to also inform you that the sub-division, I believe is named Waxhaw Manor which is located in N.C. and also neighbors the Legacy Park sub-division has had 2 vehicle break-ins along with one home burglary within the last two weeks. It has not been confirmed whether the home burglaries and vehicle burglaries are related however it's worth noting the condensed area that they are all occurring in. I would like to advise you to be more vigilant and to contact the Sheriff's Office as soon as you notice something suspicious in your neighborhood. Please continue to remove all valuables from your vehicle when you are occupying it and I advise you to document all your valuables in your home and storage buildings regardless the value of them.
