

Good morning, I would like to make you aware that within the two days there have been five vehicle break-ins in the Indian Land area. The burglaries are occurring during the night time hours. Each of these vehicles had an item stolen from them. The items in each vehicle was left in plain sight. Four of the incidents occurred in the Legacy Park sub-division during the night of February 28. The incidents occurred at the following locations: 2000 block of North Legacy Park Blvd, 2000 block of Rivendell court, 1000 block of Foxwood court and 1000 block of west Foxwood court. Three of the vehicles were locked and the windows were busted out of them, the fourth vehicle was unlocked. In one incident an empty laptop bag valued at approximately \$50 was stolen with approximately \$300 in damages to the vehicle. Remember locked or unlocked, the burglar targets vehicles with items left in plain sight. Bridge Mill sub-division is the location of the fifth incident and it occurred earlier this morning. The fifth incident information is unknown at this time.
